Tiny Dinosaur Amigurumi Pattern™



Materials:

- **YARN:** Lily Sugar n' Cream Worsted Weight 4 yarn, (100% cotton, 2.5 oz/70.9 g, 120 yds/109 m), 30-50 yds.
- **Sample Colors:** Dazzle Blue, Hot Green, Hot Orange, Black Currant
- **HOOK:** US G/6 4.0/4.25 mm
- Yarn needle, Scissors, Stitch Marker
- Scrap of black yarn for eyes, 2 oz stuffing

Gauge: 16 sc x 16 rows = 4" square
Gauge is not very important.

Experience Level: Easy

Pattern Key:

st(s) - stitch(es)
sp(s) - space(s)
ch(s) - chain(s)
sl st - slip stitch
sc - single crochet
sc2tog - decrease by sc 2 sts together
BLO - back loop only
FO - fasten off



Size: (Sizing is approximate)
6" long x 3" tall x 1.5" wide

Special Stitches:

Notes:

- Read through the entire pattern first.
- Dino body, tail, head, neck, and feet sections are worked in continuous rounds. Mark the 1st stitch of each round with a stitch marker.
- Each body part is worked separately and the dino parts are then stitched together working from head to tail.
- Repeat stitches between [and] the number of times indicated.
- See tutorial photos for assembly of the dino parts on p. 3-4.

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Pattern Directions:

DINO HEAD: (Make 1)

- Finished size is approx. 1.75" long.
- Work in continuous rounds using a stitch marker to mark the 1st st of each round.

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle, ch 1, 6 sc into magic circle, (6 sc).

Round 2: 2 sc in each st around, (12 sc).

Rounds 3-4: Sc in each st around, (12 sc, 2 rounds).

Round 5: 2 sc in next 3 sts, sc in next 9 sts, (15 sc).

Rounds 6-7: Sc in each st around, (15 sc, 2 rounds).

Round 8: Sc in next 6 sts, [sc, sc2tog,] 3 times, (12 sc).

Round 9: [Sc, sc2tog,] 4 times, (8 sc).

Stop here to embroider the eyes, then stuff the head before continuing.

Round 10: [Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog,] 2 times, (6 sc). FO and leave a long tail.

EMBROIDER THE EYES:

Make a couple of small stitches on either side of the head between rounds 6 and 7. Place the 2 eyes approximately 5 stitches apart. (Mine are placed around the 1st and 7th sts of the round.)



DINO NECK: (Make 1)

- Finished size is approx. 1.25" long.
- After R1, work in continuous rounds using a stitch marker to mark the 1st st of each round.

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle, ch 1, 7 sc into magic circle, sl st to join, (7 sc).

Round 2: *Work in BLO this round only.* Sc in BLO of each st around, do not join, (7 sc).

Rounds 3-7: Sc in each st around, (7 sc, 5 rounds). FO and leave a long tail.

Stuff the neck.

DINO BODY: (Make 1)

- Finished size is approx. 2.5" long.
- Work in continuous rounds using a stitch marker to mark the 1st st of each round.

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle, ch 1, 6 sc into magic circle, (6 sc).

Round 2: 2 sc in each st around, (12 sc).

Round 3: [Sc, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (18 sc).

Rounds 4-10: Sc in each st around, (18 sc, 7 rounds).

Round 11: [Sc, sc2tog,] 6 times, (12 sc).

Stop here and stuff the body before continuing.

Round 12: Sc2tog 6 times, (6 sc). FO and leave a long tail.

DINO FEET: (Make 4)

- Finished size is approx. 1" long.
- After R1, work in continuous rounds using a stitch marker to mark the 1st st of each round.

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle, ch 1, 6 sc into magic circle, sl st to join, (6 sc).

Round 2: *Work in BLO this round only.* Sc in BLO of each st around, do not join, (6 sc). FO and leave a long tail.

Do NOT stuff the feet.

DINO TAIL: (Make 1)

- Finished size is approx. 1.5" long.
- Work in continuous rounds using a stitch marker to mark the 1st st of each round.

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle, ch 1, 4 sc into magic circle, (4 sc).

Round 2: Sc in each st around, (4 sc).

Round 3: [Sc, 2 sc in next st,] 2 times, (6 sc).

Round 4: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 2 times, (8 sc).

Round 5: Sc in each st around, (8 sc).

Round 6: [Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 2 times, (10 sc).

Round 7: Sc in each st around, (10 sc).

Round 8: [Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 2 times, (12 sc). FO and leave a long tail.

Stuff the tail.

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FINISHING THE DINOSAUR:

HEAD:

Close the opening of the Head by passing the yarn across the opening 2-3 times and gently pull to tighten, then weave in the end. See photos below.



NECK:

Stitch the Neck to the Head. Attach the Neck centered over Rounds 9-10 of the head, on the bottom half. The Neck should stick down, not out so that it is almost perpendicular to the Head. See photos below.

BODY:

Close the opening of the Body by passing the yarn across the opening 2-3 times and gently pull to tighten. (See photos above) Do not weave in the end yet! Use the yarn end to stitch the Body to the Neck. Position the neck centered, on the top half of the Body and attach the Neck between Rounds 10-12 of the Body. The Neck should stick up from the Body, almost perpendicular. See photos below.

FEET:

Stitch the feet to the Body of the Dino on the bottom. Position the Front Feet between Rounds 9-10. with about 1 stitch in between them. Position the Back Feet between Rounds 4-5, with about 1 stitch in between them. See photos below.



TAIL:

Stitch the Tail to the Body over the end, and slightly toward the bottom of the Dino Body over Rounds 1-3. The lower the Tail is attached, the better the Dino will balance once complete. See photos below.

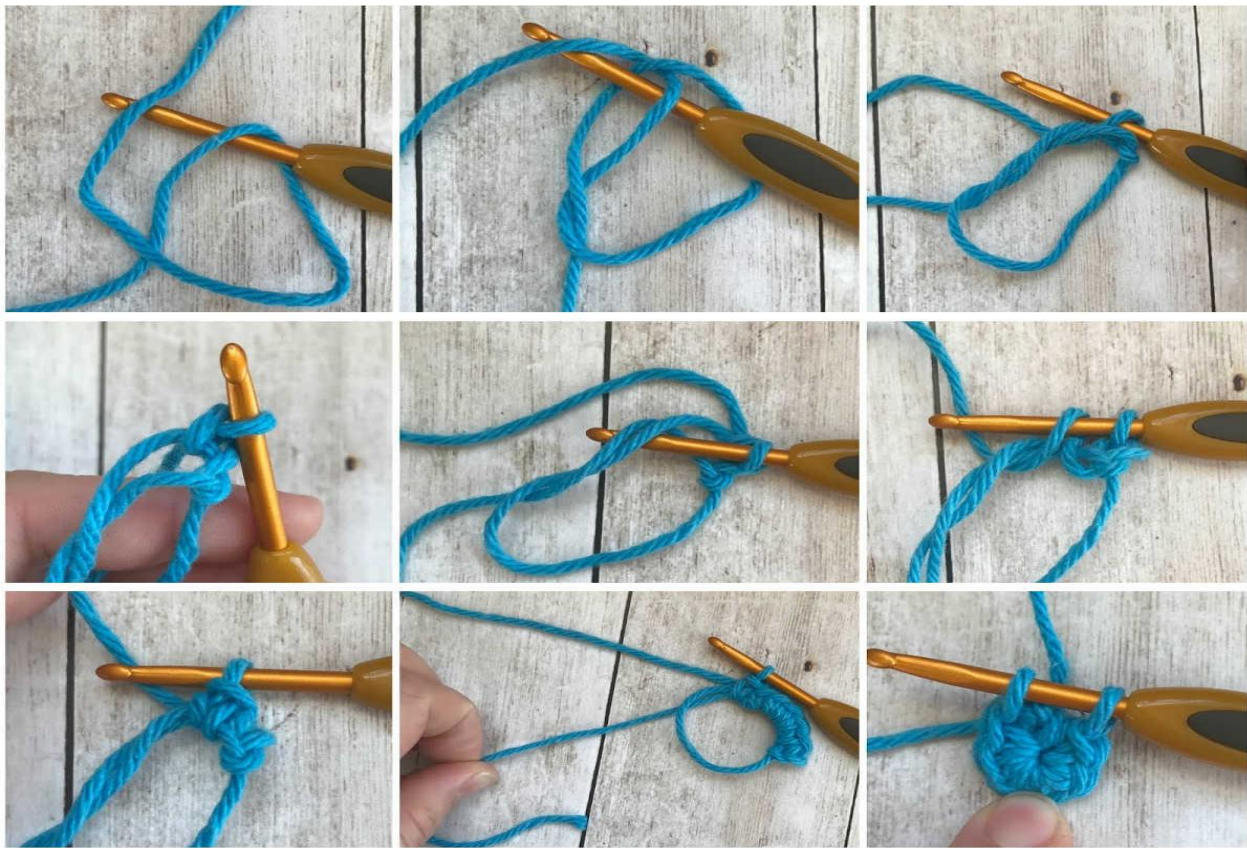

STEP 1: Create a loop with yarn, place hook through the loop, yo and pull the yarn through the loop, keeping the loop open in a circle instead of pulling the yarn tight. **STEP 2:** Ch 1, insert hook back in circle, yo and pull up a loop through the circle. **STEP 3:** Yo again and pull through the 2 loops on the hook, 1 sc completed! Repeat Step 2 to create additional stitches. Hold stitches with one hand, gently pull the yarn end with the other hand to close the circle.
