Odin the Owl Amigurumi Pattern



Materials:

- YARN: Paintbox Cotton Aran (Light)
 Worsted Weight 4 yarn, (100% cotton, 1.7 oz/50 g, 93 yds/85 m)
- **70-90 yds:** (**A**) Marine Blue.
- 30-40 yds: (B) Pansy Purple, 5-10 yds:
 (C) Paper White, (D) Mustard Yellow.
- HOOK: US G/6 4.0/4.25 mm
- Yarn needle, Scissors, Stitch Marker
- Felt/Safety eyes (12-18mm), 6 oz stuffing

Experience Level: Easy

Pattern Key:

st(s) - stitch(es)

sp(s) - space(s)

ch(s) - chain(s)

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

sc2tog - decrease by sc 2 sts together

sc3tog - decrease by sc 3 sts together

BLO - back loop only

FO - fasten off



Gauge: 16 sc x 16 rows = 4" square Gauge is not very important.

Size: (Sizing is approximate) 6" tall x 9 - 10" around

Notes:

- Read through the entire pattern first.
- Owl body, head, wings, and beak sections are worked in continuous rounds. Mark the 1st stitch of each round with a stitch marker.
- Tail is worked in rows in the BLO.
- Body and head are worked in a single joined piece. Eyes, beak, wings, tail, and feet are worked separately and stitched to the head/body.
- Beginning chain does not count as a st.
- Repeat stitches between [and] the number of times indicated.



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Pattern Directions:

OWL BODY: (Make 1)

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle with A. Ch 1, 6 sc into magic circle, (6 sc).

Round 2: 2 sc in each st around, (12 sc).

Round 3: [Sc, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (18 sc).

Round 4: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (24 sc).

Round 5: [Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (30 sc).

Round 6: [Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (36 sc).

Rounds 7-9: Sc in each st around, (36 sc, 3 rounds).

Round 10: [Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (42 sc).

Rounds 11-12: Sc in each st around, (42 sc, 2 rounds).

Round 13: [Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (48 sc).

Rounds 14-15: Sc in each st around, (48 sc, 2 rounds).

Round 16: [Sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (42 sc).

Round 17: Sc in each st around, (42 sc).

Round 18: [Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (36 sc).

Round 19: Sc in each st around, (36 sc).

Round 20: [Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (30 sc).

Round 21: Sc in each st around, (30 sc).

Round 22: [Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (24 sc).

Round 23: Sc in each st around, (24 sc).

Do not FO. Continue with Owl Head section.

OWL HEAD: (Make 1)

Round 24: 2 sc in each st around, (48 sc). Rounds 25-27: Sc in each st around, (48 sc, 3 rounds).

Stop here to stuff the body.

Round 28: [Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 6 times, (54 sc).

Rounds 29-32: Sc in each st around, (54 sc, 4 rounds).

Round 33: [Sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (48 sc).

Rounds 34-36: Sc in each st around, (48 sc, 3 rounds).

Round 37: [Sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (42 sc).

Rounds 38-40: Sc in each st around, (42 sc, 3 rounds).

Round 41: [Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (36 sc).

Round 42: [Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (30 sc).

Round 43: [Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog,] 6 times, (24 sc). SI st to next st to join.

Stop here to add eyes and beak, then stuff the head before continuing.

Fold the opening in half and bring both sides together so that the working yarn is at the edge. You will be working each stitch in this round through stitches on both sides to close the head.

Round 44: Ch 3, working each st through both sides, dc, hdc, sc, sl st in next 5 sts, sc, hdc, dc in last, ch 3 and sl st to st in the previous round to join, (6 sl st, 2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc). FO and weave in ends.



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OWL BEAK: (Make 1)

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle with D. Ch 1, 4 sc into magic circle, (4 sc).

Round 2: [Sc, 2 sc in next st,] twice, (6 sc).

Round 3; Sc in each st around, (6 sc).

Round 4: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st,] twice, (8 sc).

Round 5: Sc in each st around, (8 sc). FO and leave a long tail.

STITCH TO OWL HEAD: Flatten beak and use yarn tail to whip stitch the opening closed. Then use the yarn tail to stitch the beak to the head, centered between R27-31. I stitched mine just along the top.



OWL EYES: (Make 2)

TIP: If you plan to use safety eyes, don't tighten the magic circle until you're attaching the eyes. Then place the stems of the safety eyes through the circles for easy placement.

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle with C. Ch 1, 8 hdc, sl st to 1st st to join, (8 hdc).

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 hdc in each st around, sl st to join, (16 hdc). FO and leave a long tail.

STITCH TO OWL HEAD: Add your choice of safety or felt eyes to the whites. Stitch the eyes to the head of the owl between R30-40. Eyes should overlap a bit in the center and over the beak.

OWL WINGS: (Make 2)

Round 1: Make a Magic Circle with B. Ch 1, 6 sc into magic circle, (6 sc).

Round 2: Sc in each st around, (6 sc).

Round 3: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 2 times, (8 sc).

Round 4: Sc in each st around, (8 sc).

Round 5: [Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st,] twice, (10 sc).

Round 6: Sc in each st around, (10 sc).

Round 7: [Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st,] twice, (12 sc).

Round 8: Sc in each st around, (12 sc).

Round 9: [Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 4 times, (16 sc).

Rounds 10-11: Sc in each st around, (16 sts, 2 rounds).

Round 12: [Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st,] 4 times, (20 sc).

Rounds 13-14: Sc in each st around, (20 sts, 2 rounds).

Round 15: [Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog,] 4 times, sl st in next st to join, (16 sc).

Fold the opening in half and bring both sides together so that the working yarn is at the edge. You will be working each stitch in this round through stitches on both sides to close the wing.

Round 16: Ch 1, sc in same st (working each st through both sides), sc in next 7 sts, (8 sc). FO and leave a long tail.



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STITCH TO OWL BODY: Stitch the wings to each side of the body, right where the body and head meet, at R23. I stitched just along the top round of the wings to secure.



OWL TAIL: (Make 1)

Work in BLO, make sl sts very loose.

Row 1: With B ch 7, sc in next 4 chs, sl st in last 2 chs, turn, (2 sl st, 4 sc).

Row 2: Ch 1, sl st in BLO next 2 sts, sc in BLO next 4 sts, turn, (2 sl st, 4 sc).

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in BLO next 4 sts, sl st in

BLO last 2 sts, turn, (2 sl st, 4 sc).

Rows 4-9: Repeat Rows 2-3 alternating, ending with Row 3, (2 sl st, 4 sc, 6 rows).

Row 10: Ch 1, sl st in BLO next 6 sts, turn working across the bottom of the tail sl st in end of each row, turn working up other side of tail sl st in each ch of beginning ch, (22 sl st). FO and leave a long tail.

STITCH TO OWL BODY: Stitch the tail to the back side of the body near the bottom around R8-10. Position the tail so that the narrower edge is sewn to the body and the wider edge and slip stitched finish to the tail are facing out and up. The bottom outer edge of the tail should rest on the surface the owl sits on to help keep them upright.

OWL FEET: (Make 2)

Step 1: With D [Ch 5, sl st in next 4 chs,] 3 times, ch 1, sc3tog the ends of the 3 toes, turn, ch 4, sl st in next 3 sts, sl st to side of sc3tog to join, (16 sl sts, 1 sc). FO and leave a long tail.

STITCH TO OWL BODY: Stitch the feet to the bottom of the owl body. The feet should be positioned on either side of the magic circle, with R1-2 in between them, and the center of each foot lined up with R1. I stitched just the center of each foot down.



STEP 1: Create a loop with yarn, place hook through the loop, yo and pull the yarn through the loop, keeping the loop open in a circle instead of pulling the yarn tight. **STEP 2**: Ch 1, insert hook back in circle, yo and pull up a loop through the circle. **STEP 3**: Yo again and pull through the 2 loops on the hook, 1 sc completed! Repeat Step 2 to create additional stitches. Hold stitches with one hand, gently pull the yarn end with the other hand to close the circle.



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
